entr0py is the official radio show of C3L aired live from Radio ARA. We're on air every 4th week, so nearly once a month. The topics we're treating are widespread and of all different kinds of nature; from ITSecurity to the cyberpolitical realities in all of our live, the heaviest bugfucks of the month, as the analysis of technologies in its detail. The name entr0py has come from [virii](#) within a jam session to find a name. Our team consists of 2 - 3 people who'll attend regular in the shows. For the rest we'll have all different sorts of guests or interviews for our listeners.
